Honoring Connecticut's 2026 Environmental Champions

Each year, Aquarion's Environmental Champion Awards recognize dedicated volunteers who help safeguard and improve Connecticut's natural environment. On June 6, this year's winners were celebrated during a special ceremony at Connecticut's Beardsley Zoo.

The awards in this year's categories went to:

Bigelow Tea Company (Large Business) Founded in 1945, Bigelow Tea is a Certified B Corporation recognized for its high-quality teas and strong commitment to sustainability. The Fairfield-based company has maintained Zero-Waste-to-Landfill operations since 2012, reduced its carbon footprint through renewable energy initiatives, and supports environmental stewardship through community education and conservation efforts.

Reboot Eco (Small Business) Founded in 2021 in Middletown, Reboot Eco promotes sustainable, low-waste living through reusable-container shopping and eco-friendly household products. Its community programs, including repair cafes, mending circles, and the swap studio, help reduce landfill waste, curb single-use plastics, and build practical sustainability skills.

Trumbull Nature & Arts Center (Non-Profit) For more than 15 years, the Trumbull Nature & Arts Center has provided environmental education and nature-based experiences, reaching more than 13,000 Bridgeport students through grant-funded programs. Its commitment to



accessibility and watershed-focused educational resources continue to promote environmental stewardship and sustainability across the community.

Maggie Favretti (Adult) Co-founder of the Alliance for the Mystic River Watershed, Maggie has united six communities to advance clean water, healthy ecosystems, and environmental resilience. By securing significant funding to assess watershed risks and supporting youth climate initiatives, she has strengthened environmental stewardship and inspired future leaders.

Tomás Gutiérrez (Student) A junior at Killingly High School, Tomás designed and launched his project, Biodiversity: Survival Through Education, delivering workshops to approximately 180 students and significantly increasing their understanding of biodiversity. As an environmental leader, environmental club founder and president, and Klinck Scholarship recipient, he is inspiring environmental stewardship while preparing to study Natural Resources at the University of Connecticut.
