



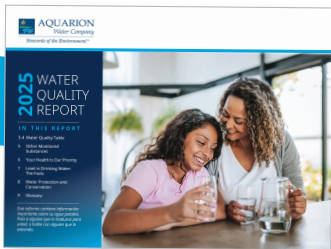

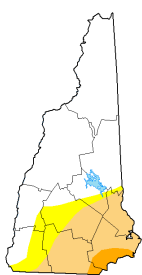

Honoring New Hampshire's 2026 Environmental Champions

Each year, Aquarion's Environmental Champion Awards recognize dedicated volunteers who help safeguard and improve New Hampshire's natural environment. On June 18, this year's winners were celebrated during a special ceremony at the Seacoast Science Center in Odiorne State Park.

The awards in this year's categories went to:

Throwback Brewery (Business) Located in North Hampton, Throwback Brewery is a sustainability-focused brewery committed to producing beer with 100% local ingredients. Since 2011, it has prioritized water conservation, solar power, composting, recyclable packaging, and local sourcing, while partnering with community organizations to promote environmental awareness across New England.

Gundalow Company (Non-Profit) The Gundalow Company is committed to protecting the Piscataqua region's maritime heritage through hands-on education. Aboard a replica 19th-century gundalow, students and community members learn about maritime history, marine science, navigation, and conservation, inspiring stewardship of local rivers, bays, and natural resources.



Andrew Vorkink (Adult) A dedicated conservation leader in North Hampton, Andrew Vorkink has advanced land protection, wetland preservation, and trail development since 2015. Through strategic land acquisitions, public education, and creation of the Oliver Brook Trail, he has expanded access to nature while helping safeguard the community's natural resources for future generations.

Anna Doherty (Student) A Hampton high school senior, Anna Doherty is a researcher, educator, and advocate for marine conservation. Through coral research, environmental outreach, and her children's book *My Blue Ocean*, she inspires environmental stewardship. This fall, she will attend the University of Miami to study Oceanography and advance her passion for coral conservation.
