Surprisingly, fire is another danger. Each year, people trying to thaw a frozen pipe with an open flame end up accidentally setting flammable materials ablaze.



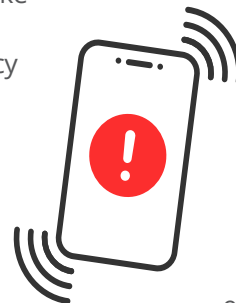
