

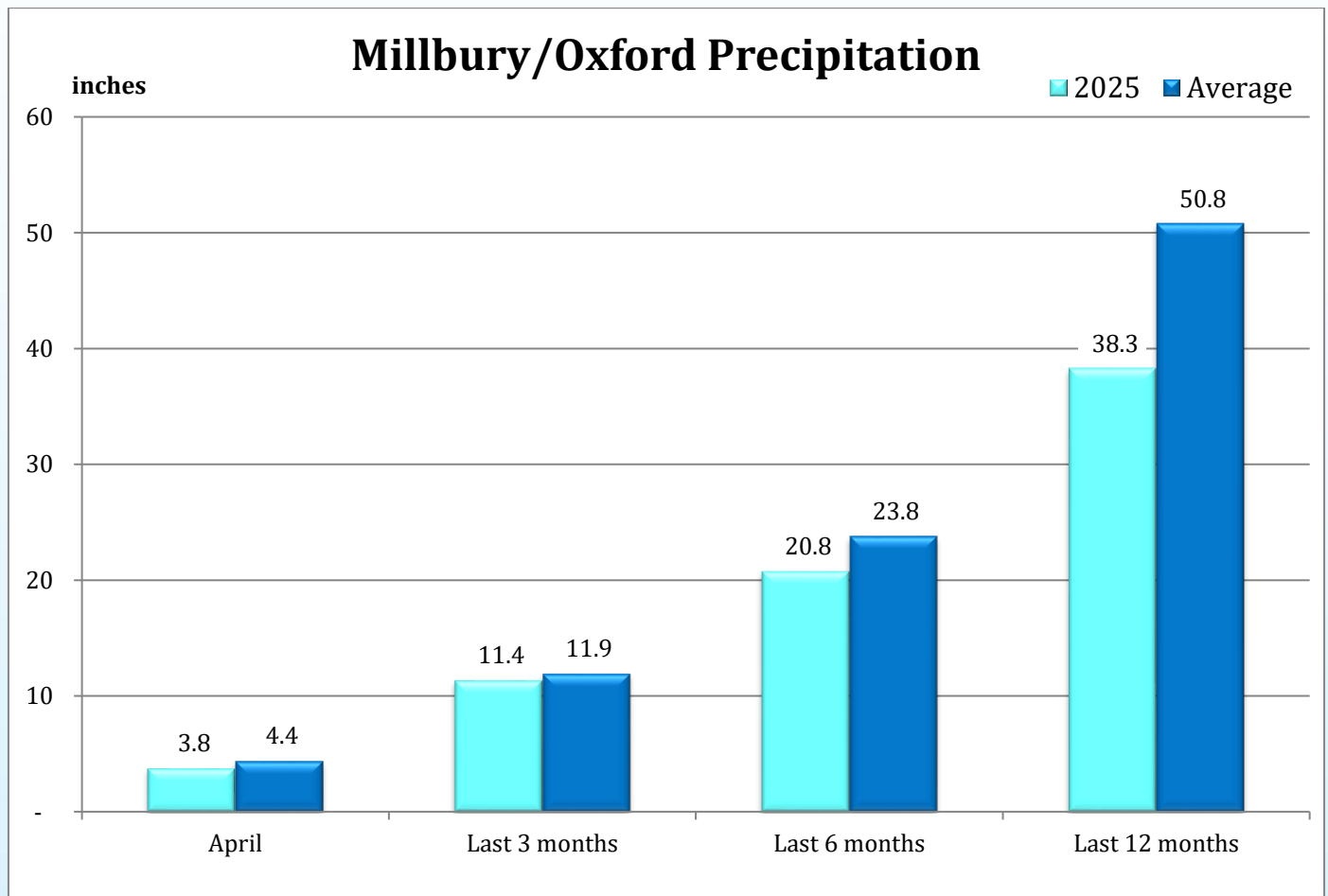


Water Supply Update

Serving the Communities of Millbury and Oxford

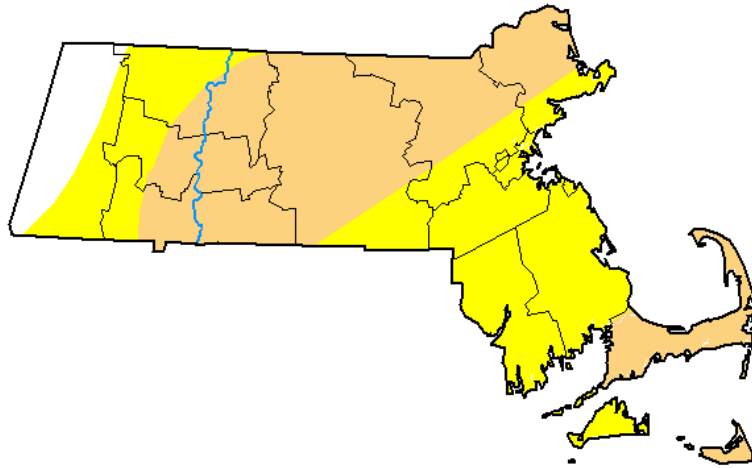
Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 3.77 inches in April. This amount was less than the long-term average of 4.5 inches. This is consistent with the data from the last twelve months as Millbury/Oxford has seen substantially less precipitation than an average year for this region. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level 0 – Abnormally Dry.
