


## Water Supply Update

## Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 0.81 inches in June. This amount was significantly less than the long-term average of 4.3 inches. This is consistent with the data from the last twelve months as Millbury/Oxford has seen substantially less precipitation than an average year for this region. Millbury and Oxford are currently not in drought.
