
Water Supply Update

Weather Trends/Outlook

Precipitation totaled 3.78 inches in March. This amount was slightly more than the long-term average of 3.7 inches. However, in the last twelve months, Millbury/Oxford has seen substantially less precipitation than an average year for this region. Millbury and Oxford are currently at Drought Level 1 – Moderate Drought.
